

How Do I drop off my Kids

Puggles and Cubbies will be dropped off in their room. Parents will register them at the door each night and be given a security sticker that you must turn in to pick up your child.

Sparks and Breakout will be dropped off at the Chapel. Sparks will report to the office side of the chapel and Breakout to the bridge side to register each night.

How Do I pick up my Kids

For your child's safety children will not be allowed to leave their drop off area until the parent comes in person to pick them up. Children will not be released to be picked up in the parking lot.

If you are picking up multiple children it is best to pick up your youngest child first.

Puggles and Cubbies (Preschool):

You will pick your child up in the same place that you dropped them off. Preschoolers will only be released to the person that has the matching sticker.

Sparks (K-2nd Grade)

Sparks will be picked up, upstairs in their Bible study rooms. Children will only be released to those that are approved on the Navigate Registration form. As a result, be sure to put everyone down that may be picking your child up during the year. If you arrange for someone that is not listed we must be notified before the child is dropped off.

Breakout (3rd-6th Grade)

Sparks will be picked up in the Chapel. Children will only be released to those that are approved on the Navigate Registration form. As a result, be sure to put everyone down that may be picking your child up during the year. If you arrange for someone that is not listed we must be notified before the child is dropped off

NAVIGATE

Navigate is our Wednesday Night Ministry for ages 2 years to 6th grade. We call it Navigate because we help kids NAVIGATE through the scripture and show them how to apply it to their lives. This is done with a combination of two age appropriate curriculums called AWANA and Breakout. Through this program we believe kids will learn the foundations to become strong Christian leaders who love God, people, and service.


First Kids Mission Statement

First Kids is devoted to doing whatever it takes to meet the needs of kids and their parents in the name of Jesus.

The Partnership

Our Children's Ministry will achieve its mission by being a partnership with parents. Deuteronomy 6:4-9 essentially tells those who desire to follow Christ to love the Lord with all their heart, soul and strength, and to talk about the Word of God at home or wherever we go. We are to raise children within our family at home and at church to follow Him with our whole hearts and lives. This partnership between parents and the church will give us the best chance possible to develop children who love God, Love People and Love to Serve.

For this reason we believe families that have a strong emphasis on spiritual development at home will develop into Kids who put God first. First Kids is here to help give you tools that you can use at home. Our challenge through the Navigate program is for you to use this material at home and we will commit to reinforce the Christian values that you are instilling.

(2 - 3 years old, not yet potty-trained):



Awana Puggles teaches toddlers simple lessons through teaching cards, activities, music and more. Awana Puggles leaders have a guidebook to help them plan and direct club time and communicate the lesson.



Cubbies (3 - 5 years old, potty-trained)

Cubbies is fun with a purpose – to reach and train kids for Jesus Christ. Games, puppets, crafts, awards and other activities transform our preschool program into a lively, weekly experience where fun and learning go hand in hand.



Sparks (Kindergarten - 2nd Grade)

The Sparks club for children in kindergarten through second grade builds on the material taught in our preschool clubs. The curriculum takes kids a step deeper into God's Word while giving boys and girls regular opportunities to hear the gospel and come to faith in Jesus Christ. After being immersed in solid foundational teaching at the preschool level, boys and girls frequently come to an understanding of their need to trust Christ as their personal Savior while in Sparks.



Breakout (3rd - 6th Grade)

Breakout has grown out of the **Purpose Driven Life** series. We are very excited about this program and how we can help your child grow in Christ in ways we never dreamed of before. A child who stays in this program will go through a series of four books: *How to Know Christ, How to Grow in Christ, How to Serve Christ and How to Share Christ..* A child who begins in book 1 and finishes in book 4 will have the opportunity to apply what they have learned by going on a mission trip.



How Do I Enroll:

Come to the Kick-off Registration Night on Wednesday September 2nd in the Fellowship Hall.

New Registration:

You can retrieve or request from the church office the Navigate Registration Form. Fill it out completely and turn it in to the Navigate Registration table during the Kick-Off Registration or Opening Night.

If Registered Last Year:

If you were enrolled in the Navigate Ministry last year you will need to contact the Church office or come to the Registration and Kick off Night. You will need to verify or make any necessary changes to last years information and let us know which club your child will be joining.

How Much Does it Cost

Navigate is a free program however we do take offering each week for the Navigate program and to support our Missionaries in Nicaragua.

The First Kids/Navigate Calendar is available on the Church Website. What are Navigate Points

Cubbies and Sparks earn Navigate points for showing up, being in uniform, and memorizing scripture. They will be able to spend their points at the Navigate store nights at the end of December and April.

Breakout earns Navigate Points for showing up, wearing their T-Shirt, and completing activities in their books. The points can be applied to most trips and activities First Kids Offers. They can also be used on Summer Events such as Kids Camp. The points do start over at the beginning of a new Navigate year.
