



CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

The Night Ministry® is committed to protecting the confidences and confidentiality of those we meet. In order for those we serve to feel safe and willing to form ongoing relationships, they must feel they can trust all associated with The Night Ministry. We expect all staff, volunteers, and guests to maintain the confidentiality of our parishioners. This means:

- You may share the content of your encounters with The Night Ministry staff present on the Bus or Van and other volunteers with you on the streets. You may want to share some of your experiences with friends, family, co-workers. Please do this in a way that the person about whom you are speaking cannot be identified.
- NEVER share information about one parishioner or guest with another parishioner/guest. You do not know who knows whom on the streets.
- When you are in other settings, do not acknowledge parishioners or guests that you have met through your time with The Night Ministry, unless they acknowledge you first.
- NEVER disclose the names of parishioners or guests without approval from the Team Leader.

I understand the information above. I am comfortable with and willing to follow these guidelines. If I feel uncomfortable with any portion of this policy, I am responsible for clarifying this with the Team Leader from The Night Ministry before beginning my volunteer shift.
