Dates: June 19 – 25 (week 3) (June 19-20 = mandatory team leader weekend)

Cost: Free (includes meals during the week, t-shirt, lodging, & materials) \$150 will be paid on your behalf by the church.

Ages: Must have graduated from high school for a least one year.

Requirements?

1. Have made a commitment to follow Jesus (accepted Jesus as personal Lord & Savior).
2. Have an active devotional life (consistently reading the Bible & praying)
3. *Regularly* attends, and is a member of First Baptist Church of Claremore.
4. Have a positive witness/testimony outside of church.
5. Willing to share your faith with your peers.
6. Have a heart for students and be willing to invest in their lives.
7. Obey all the rules of Super Summer.
8. Be willing to lead small group discussions.
9. Be happy & positive!
10. Must be recommended by the student pastor.

SCHOOL INFORMATION:

Red School - For all students entering 8th Grade in the fall of 2010

Blue School - For all students entering 9th Grade in the fall of 2010

Orange School - For all students entering 10th Grade in the fall of 2010

Yellow School - For all students entering 11th Grade in the fall of 2010

Green School - For all students entering 12th Grade in the fall of 2010

Silver School - For those just graduating high school in the spring of 2010

Purple School - Designed specifically for students who feel the call of God for vocational Christian service. The Purple School Students must be recommended by their pastor for admission to this school and must have completed 11th Grade.

TEAM LEADER INFORMATION:

Each church sending students **must** provide Team Leaders. The formula for numbers is based on one (1) Team Leader for every seven (7) students [i.e.: 1 to 7 students requires 1 Team Leader; 8 to 14 students requires 2 Team Leaders; etc.].

Our Team Leaders are a vital part of Super Summer **must** attend Team Leader training weekend (Saturday and Sunday before their camp week). They serve as encouragers, discussion leaders, friends and dorm supervisors to a group of 10 to 12 students. During the week, Team Leaders become a “Mom” or “Dad” to our students and minister to each student. **This assignment demands a spiritually mature and growing person. Make sure the people you send are above reproach, walking with God and of good moral character.**

PLEASE NOTE: If for some reason you cannot find a Team Leader for your group, YOU MUST STILL PAY FOR THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF TEAM LEADERS REGISTRATION. Work very hard to meet the 1 to 7 ratio. This is vital to our success.

MANDATORY: All Team Leaders should check in at the Geiger Center by 2:00pm on the Saturday of Team Leader Weekend. Week 1 Saturday, June 5th; Week 2 Saturday, June 12th; and Week 3 Saturday, June 19th. Room assignments and schedules will be given at that time. Team Leaders must stay on campus and carry out all assigned responsibilities until Friday afternoon of their respective week.

TEAM LEADERS SHOULD:

1. Be recommended by their Pastor/Youth Pastor.
2. Be a spiritually mature/growing person who has been out of high school at least one year at the start of Super Summer.
3. Be a happy, positive person.
4. Have a heart for young people and be willing to invest his/her life in the lives of students.
5. Obey the rules of Super Summer – ***just like the students.***
6. Be willing to lead in small group discussions following large group teaching.
7. Attend the Team Leader Training Weekend the Saturday, Sunday, and Monday before Super Summer begins. The dates for the Team Leader Training are as follows:
 - Week 1 – Saturday, June 5 – Monday, June 7
 - Week 2 – Saturday, June 12 – Monday, June 14
 - Week 3 – Saturday, June 19 – Monday, June 21.
